Short-term Closure

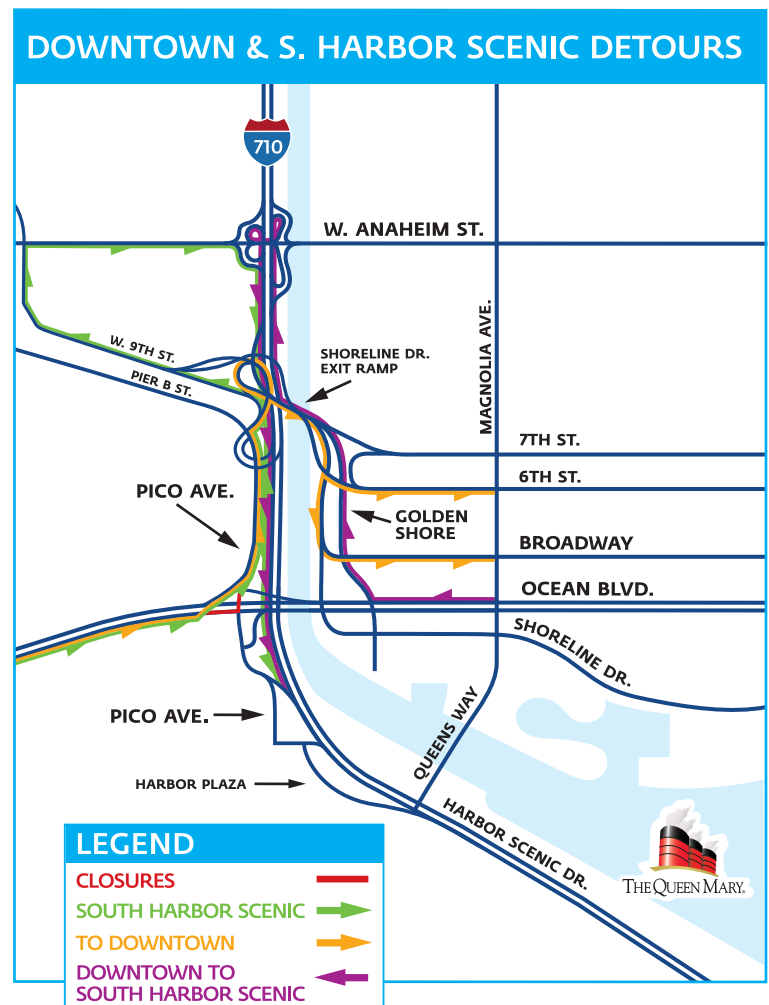
Temporary Road Closures July 27-30

Date: July 27-30, 2018

Duration: 3 days

CLOSURE: Beginning at 9 p.m., on Friday, July 27, routes along Pico Avenue will be temporarily closed for the demolition of the former northbound I-710 connector ramp. Motorists traveling through the area are advised to allow extra time to reach their destination. The closure will end by 5 a.m., Monday, July 30.

- **Detour to Downtown Long Beach:** If traveling east on Ocean Boulevard into the city, exit at Pico Avenue, turn left to head north, turn right onto 9th Street, continue onto 10th Street, then take the downtown on-ramp onto Shoreline Drive.
- **Detour to South Harbor Scenic Drive:** If traveling east on Ocean Boulevard, exit at Pico Avenue, turn left to head north, turn right onto 9th Street, then continue north up to Anaheim Street. Turn right onto Anaheim Street, take the exit onto I-710 south, then follow the signs to "Port Queen Mary."
- **From Downtown to South Harbor Scenic Drive:** If traveling west on Ocean Boulevard, turn right onto northbound Golden Shore and I-710, exit at westbound Anaheim Street, take the on-ramp to I-710 south, then follow the signs to "Port Queen Mary."



NOTE: During these closures, westbound Ocean Boulevard traffic will be unaffected. Both northbound and southbound Harbor Scenic Drive will also remain open.
