Long-term Closure

Pier T Eastbound Ocean Blvd. On-Ramp Closure

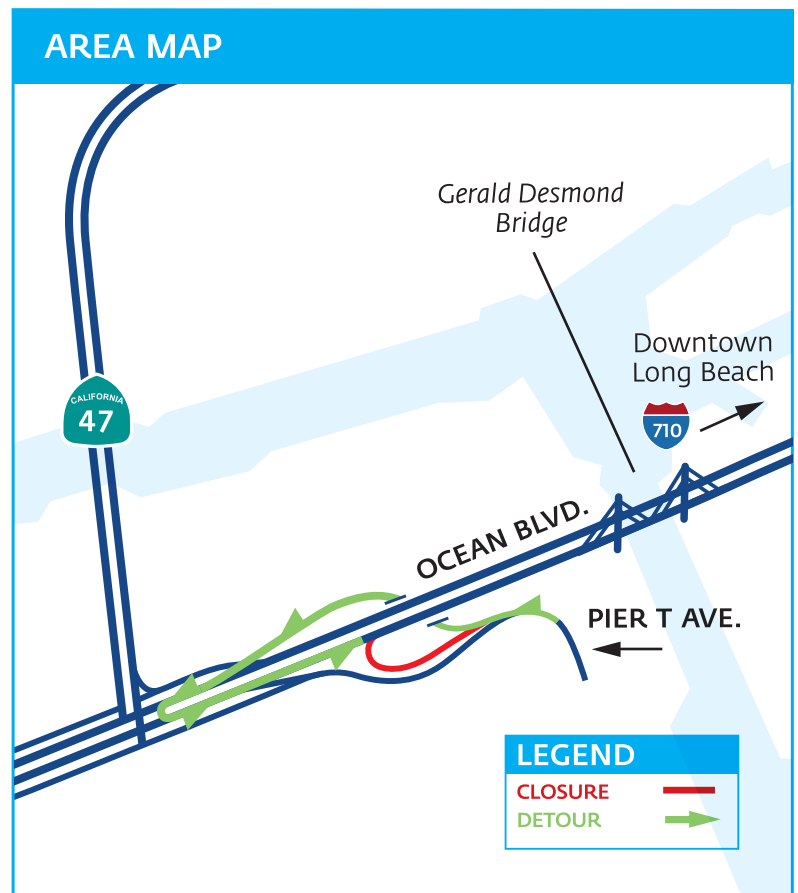
Date: July 20, 2019

Duration: Permanent

CLOSURE: Beginning 5 a.m. on Saturday, July 20, eastbound traffic patterns on the Gerald Desmond Bridge will change when the eastbound Ocean Boulevard loop on-ramp from Pier T Avenue on Terminal Island will close permanently to enable construction crews to build new roadways on the south side of Ocean Boulevard.

The detour for all vehicles headed east from Pier T Avenue will be to use the SR-47 connector road, followed by the PAUC (Port Access Under Crossing), a free U-turn at the intersection of Ocean Boulevard and SR-47. As motorists approach the intersection, they will shift to the far left two lanes, and make a smooth unsignalized turn through the PAUC to head east. Stay to the left to take the on-ramp to North 710, Piers B-J, Downtown.

Motorists are advised to monitor traffic conditions and allow additional time to travel this section of the construction area.
