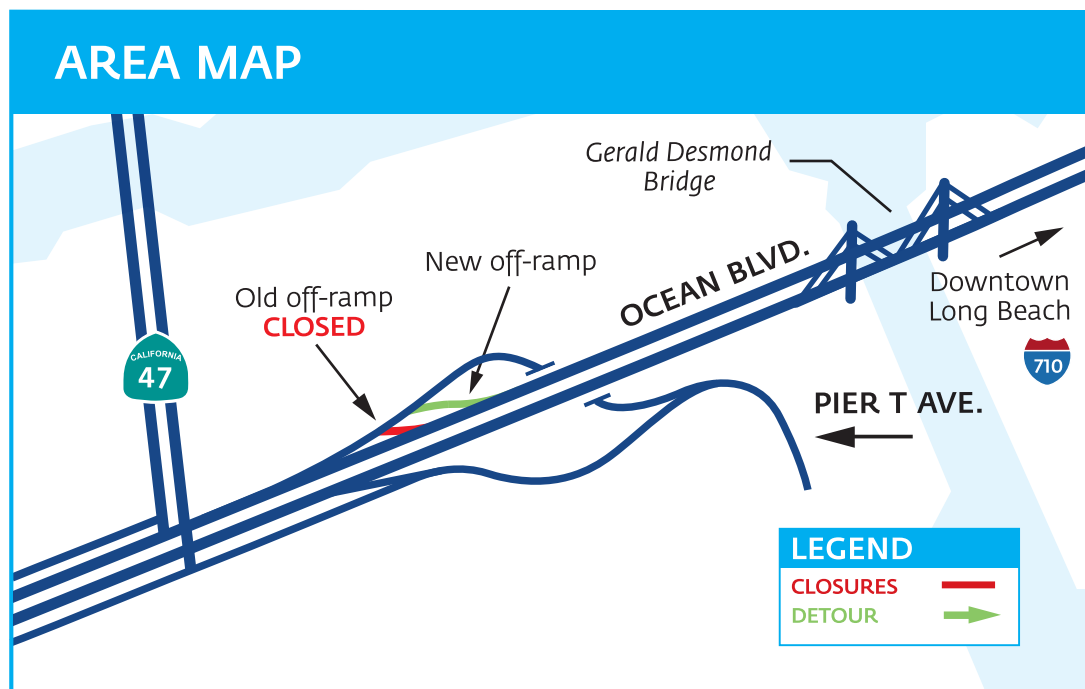
Moving Off-Ramp to SR-47/SR-103 on Westbound Ocean Blvd.

Date: July 20, 2019

Duration: Permanent

CLOSURE: Beginning 5 a.m. on Saturday, July 20, westbound traffic patterns on Ocean Boulevard after the descent from the Gerald Desmond Bridge will change with the move of the off-ramp to SR-47, SR-103, Piers A S. The off-ramp will move approximately 400 feet (122 meters) to the east, closer to the current bridge. This means that – for motorists coming down the westbound decline on the current bridge who want to take the off-ramp – it will appear sooner.

Motorists are encouraged to get into the right lane as they come down the bridge to avoid abrupt lane shifts or merging as they approach the off-ramp.
